Please Read the rules listed below, Sign, & Return the application page, **with your full payment**. FULL PAYMENT IS EXPECTED BEFORE August 10, 2019. NO PARTIAL PAYMENTS ARE ACCEPTED. NO CASH PAYMENTS ACCEPTED, ONLY CHECKS or MONEY ORDERS made out to: Georgetown Lions Club. **NO REFUNDS DUE TO WEATHER OR ACTS OF GOD. It is important that you read these rules carefully, especially those that are bold. It is your responsibility to see that these rules are obeyed.

1. Each booth space is 10' wide and 10' deep. You are limited to this space since they are placed side by side. Booth contents, merchandise, and operators are required to stay within the boundaries of contracted space. (One space- 10'x10', two-20'x10', three-30'x10', etc.). We reserve the right to refuse or reject any booth anytime for rules violation or questionable operations. ALL SPACES ARE OUTDOORS.
2. This event is only accepting Booth rental for **non- food** booths. Your FULL PAYMENT for booth rental is due before August 10, 2019. NO PARTIAL PAYMENTS ARE ACCEPTED. NO CASH PAYMENTS ACCEPTED, only CHECKS or MONEY ORDERS made out to Georgetown Lions Club. Applications will be taken until August 10, 2019. Refunds will be made for cancellation before August 17, 2019; however, because of expenses incurred 25% of your deposit will not be returned. Refunds after August 17th are at the discretion of the event committee. Your cancelled check will serve as your confirmation. Completely fill out the application form. Failure to do so may invalidate your booth reservation.
3. Booth setup is the morning of Sept 2nd.When you arrive at the Optimist Club, a registration table with your booth information will be outside the entrance at the back of the building. YOU MUST CHECK IN TO OBTAIN YOUR BOOTH NUMBER . All booths are in the grass. Pop up tents must be weighted down, no spikes can be used. We do not have the manpower to assist you in setting up your booths or products. You are responsible for bringing your own tables and chairs.
4. All booths must be operated and occupied during the scheduled hours of 8:00AM-4:00PM, booth area must be left clean. Vendors are responsible for the proper disposal of waste from their booth. Garbage collection bins will be provided.
5. If you are holding a drawing for any item in your booth you must apply for, obtain, and submit to Indiana Gaming for a license for said drawing (no exceptions). This is your responsibility and if it is not obtained the drawing may not be held. It is the responsibility of the booth representative to supply winners of any drawing giveaways with item that was advertised.
6. All booths must visibly display name of booth, sponsoring organizations, and booth number.
7. The Georgetown Lions Picnic and Rod Run is a family –oriented event. We do not allow materials we deem inappropriate to be displayed or sold, including guns (of any kind), knives (of any kind) or other weapons (of any kind). We do not allow shirts or objects we consider lewd or displaying offensive language or caricatures. No fart spray, silly string, invisible ink or other item that is not acceptable to the committee. We reserve the right to ask you to remove such items from your booth. Failure to comply can result in your expulsion and future banning from our event. All decisions rest with the booth Committee Directors. The following items are not allowed in booth area: alcohol, glass bottles, disruptive speakers, radios, sound systems, music, and bullhorns. In addition, no slides, posters, movies, or material that may be considered offensive will be allowed. NO LIVE ANIMALS OR REPTILES ARE TO BE GIVEN AWAY AS PRIZES!

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ILLEGAL GOODS AND PROHIBITED ITEMS: NO ILLEGAL goods of any kind are to be sold on the Optimist Club property including the HYR park or at the Georgetown Lions Picnic and Rod Run. These items include but not limited to: fireworks, drugs or drug paraphernalia, alcohol for sale, no laser pointers, counterfeit merchandise and/or merchandise that infringe upon any registered trademarks or copyright laws (clothes, purses, jewelry, DVDs, etc.) Any discovery of illegal goods will be reported immediately to the proper authorities and you will be asked to leave immediately.

8. The Labor Day Directors reserve the right to assign booth locations, establish the placement of booth locations, and to refund or reject any booth any time for rules violation or questionable operations.

9. No vehicles of any type, are allowed in the grass (except for the designated area for the rod run). Vendors can park on the pavement behind the Optimist Club to unload for setup and load for teardown, but will need to move to the designated parking area during the event, due to the limited parking space.

10. No booth location may be sublet.

11. Booth operators are required to stay within the boundaries of contracted booth space. Booth operators may not sell or distribute materials from the back of their booth or outside of their booth. Aisle ways are to be kept clear.

12. No electrical hookups are available.

13. Water: Any water that is needed by you, will need to be provided by you.

14. Bathrooms are located INSIDE the Optimist Club.

15. The Georgetown Lions are not responsible for anything stolen or damaged.

16. NO PETS ARE ALLOWED on the grounds unless they are a service animal with proper paperwork.

The Georgetown Lions Club will have food and drinks for sale from 8:00AM-4:00PM; and tables set up inside the Optimist Club, for eating.
